CHURCH ROAD CEMETERY - STANDARD FEES
(Effective from 11th November 2025)

N.B. Please see the note below re discounts for parish residents

1.	<u>Interment (Excluding all charges for labour): For the interment of the body of:</u>	
a)	A stillborn child or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 1 month:	Free
b)	A child aged at the time of death exceeded 1 month but did not exceed 18 years.	£270
c)	A person whose age at the time of death exceeded 18 years.	£540
d)	For the interment of the ashes of a cremated body in a space not exceeding 2' x 2' (610 mm x 610 mm), or in an existing grave:	£270
2.	<u>Exclusive Right of Burial (for 50 years)</u>	
a)	For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave:	£750
b)	For the exclusive right of burial of urns of cremated ashes (in a grave space reserved for that purpose):	£380
3.	<u>Gravestones, Tablets and Monumental Inscriptions - Full Grave</u>	
	For the right to erect or place:	
a)	A headstone or cross [not exceeding 2' 6" height, 2' width and depth (base) 1' (762 mm, 610 mm & 304mm) subject to the overall vertical dimensions not exceeding 5 sq. ft (0.45 sq. m)]:	£270
b)	A tablet not exceeding 6" (152 mm) height and 2' by 2' square in area:	£270
c)	Any inscription, after the first, on a memorial	Free
4.	<u>Gravestones, Tablets and Inscriptions - Ashes Graves Only</u>	
	For the right to erect or place:	
a)	A small headstone not exceeding 2' height, 1' 6" width & depth (base) 1' marking the interment of an urn containing ashes:	£270
b)	A tablet not exceeding 6" (152 mm) height and 1'6" by 1'6" square in area:	£270
c)	Any inscription, after the first, on a memorial	Free

Hanborough Parish Burials

- a) For the burial of deceased persons resident within the Parish of Hanborough at the time of death the above fees shall be subject to a discount of 50%.
- b) Please consult the Finance Officer for fees applicable for a person aged less than 18 years and a resident within the Parish of Hanborough at the date of death.
- c) For the burial of deceased persons for whom a long-term residence within the Parish of Hanborough can be shown, but have not resided within the parish because of a need to reside in a residential or nursing home or with relatives resident outside of the Parish of Hanborough, the above fees shall be reduced by 50%.
- d) The Council shall have the right to vary the above discount percentage and its eligibility at any time at its discretion. Any variation shall be authorised on behalf of the Council by a unanimous decision of the Council's Cemetery Management Representatives and shall be reported to the next meeting of the Council together with the reasons for any such variation.

Exclusive Rights and Non Exclusive Rights

The purchase of exclusive rights gives rights to a second interment and to the right to erect a Gravestone or Tablet (subject to the payment of the appropriate fee and to approval by the council of the dimensions, design and inscription on the memorial). Interments without the purchase of an exclusive right give neither secondary burial rights nor the right to erect a Gravestone, Tablet or other Memorial. The council also reserves the right to permit a second interment in the same grave space to any other party where exclusive rights are not purchased at the time of the first interment.
